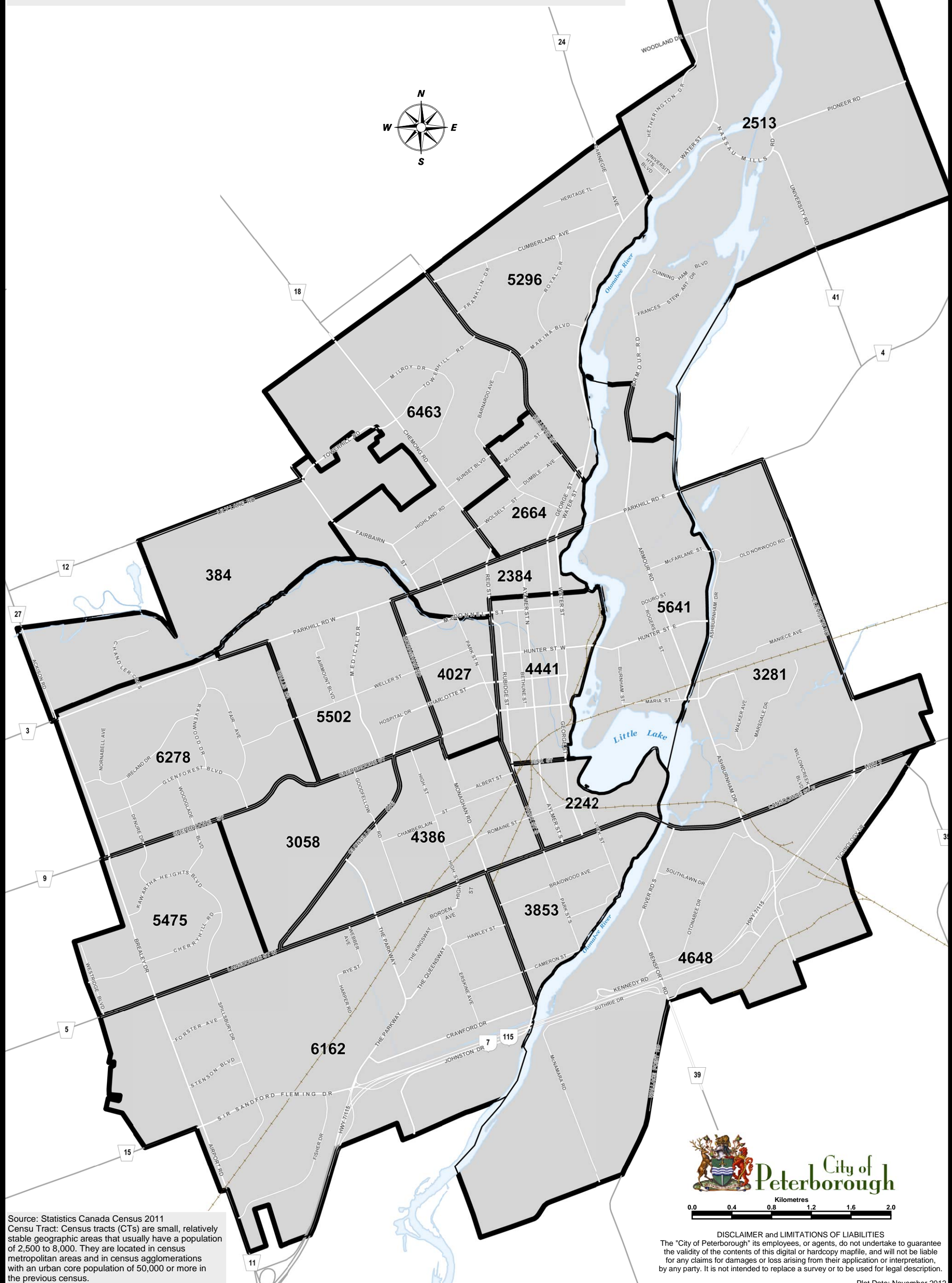
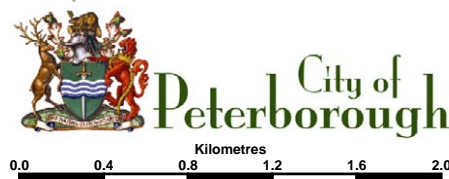


# Population in 2011 by Census Tract in the City of Peterborough
