

Bucks Back to Work Round One Evaluation Criteria FAQs

- 1. What specific areas of a business' financial situation were evaluated?
 - a. Assistance received from other government sources
 - b. Percentage decrease in sales
 - c. Difference in cash available between Dec. 31st, 2019 and May 21-26, 2020
 - d. Total annual revenue
 - e. Full and Part Time employees
- 2. What types of industries applied?
 - a. Accommodation and food service
 - b. Agriculture, forestry, farm, fishing and hunting
 - c. Art, design, sport, entertainment, and media
 - d. Business and financial operations
 - e. Construction, installation, maintenance and repair
 - f. Education, training and library
 - g. Health care and social assistance
 - h. Manufacturing and production
 - i. Professional, scientific, and technical professional services
 - i. Retail, trade, sales and related
 - k. Other Majority of applicants
- 3. Where were eligible businesses located?
 - a. All but four municipalities had eligible businesses
 - b. The top three were Doylestown Borough, Buckingham Township and Bensalem Township
- 4. What are some additional considerations that went into the approval process?
 - a. How long the business has been owned by the current owner
 - b. Whether the business is a franchise or affiliate
 - c. The completeness of the application packet
- 5. If a business was deemed ineligible for this round, or submitted an incomplete application, will it be eligible for round two of this program?

Yes. Any business or business owner that did not receive a grant through our first round will be eligible for our second round so long as the business meets the updated requirements of the program. We hope to have these requirements out to potential applicants shortly.
